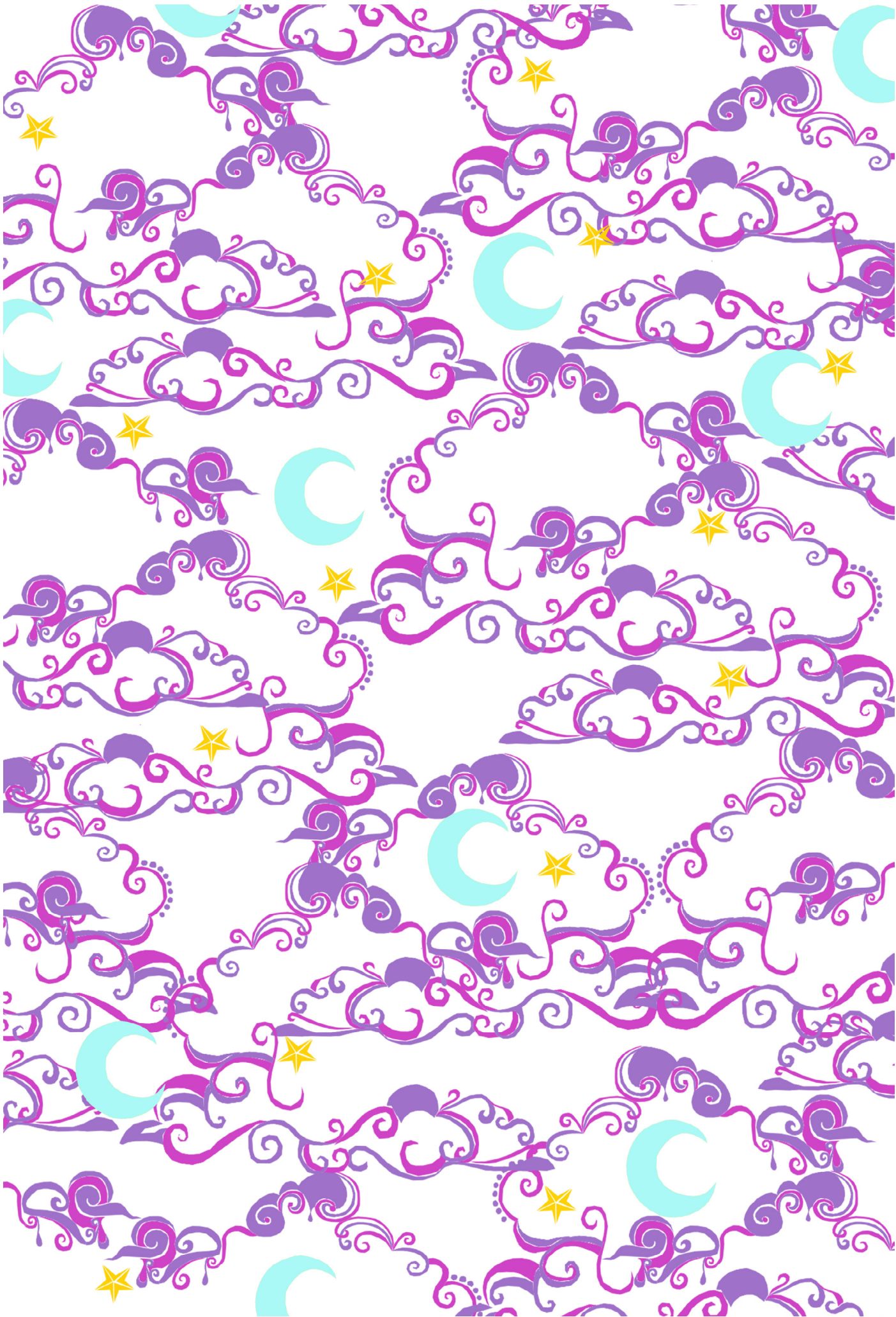
Up in the clouds, Hero Design

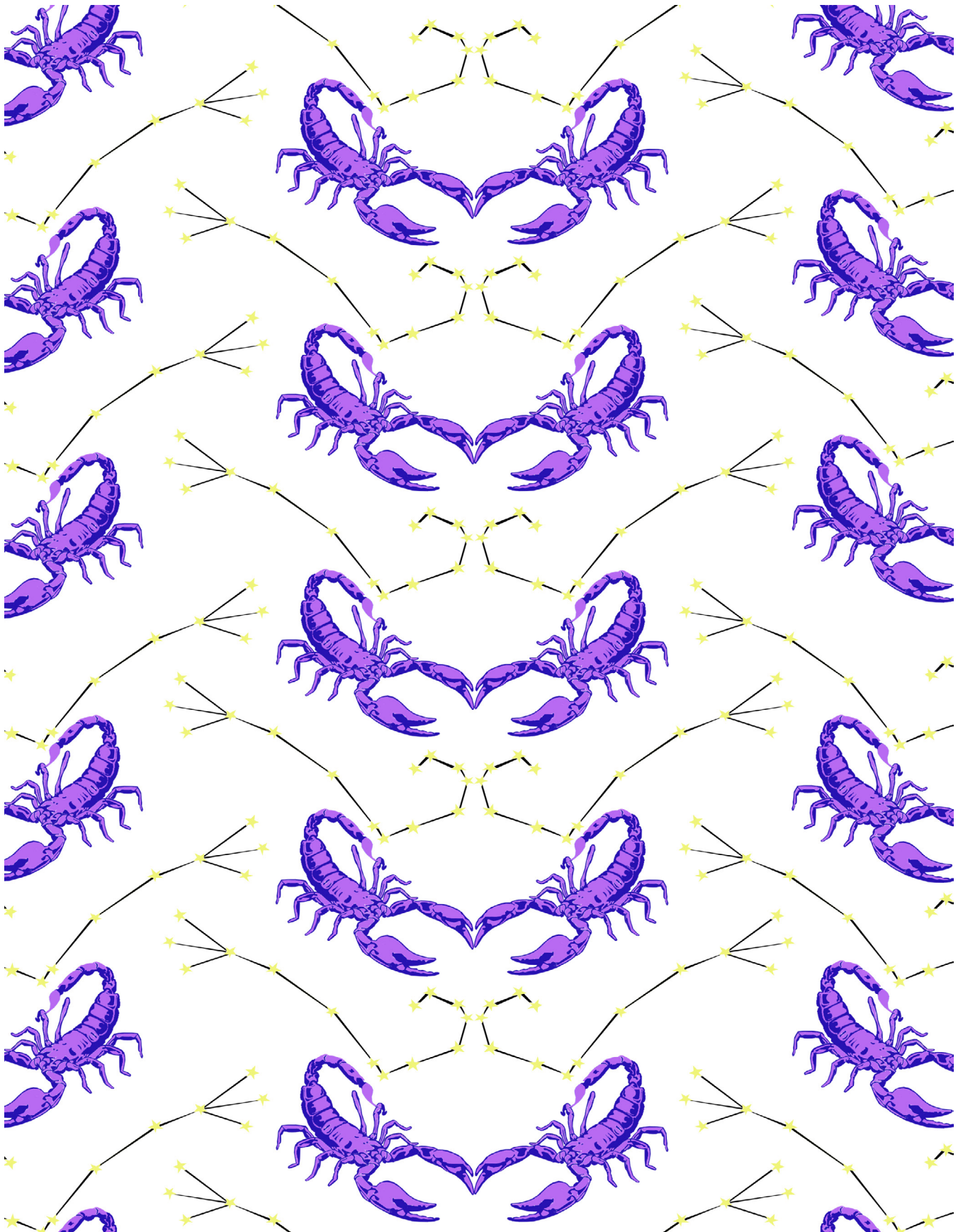
I would use this pattern on a luxury silk and then embellish with stitch detailing and using sparkles and beads.

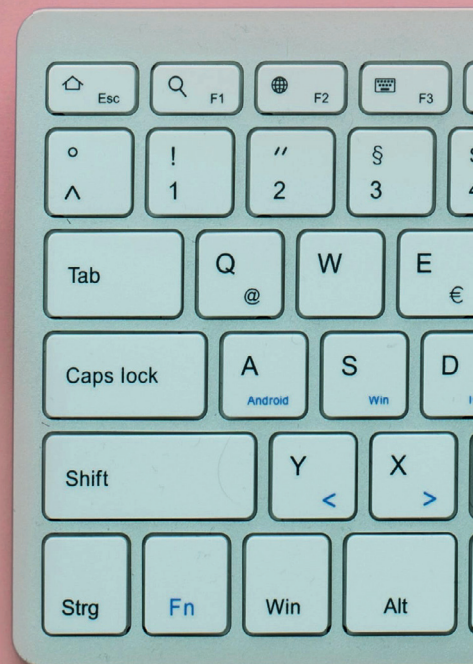
I believe that this pattern can be used on lots of different items, I have shown it on a calander but i also think that it would look good on a journal/diary cover.

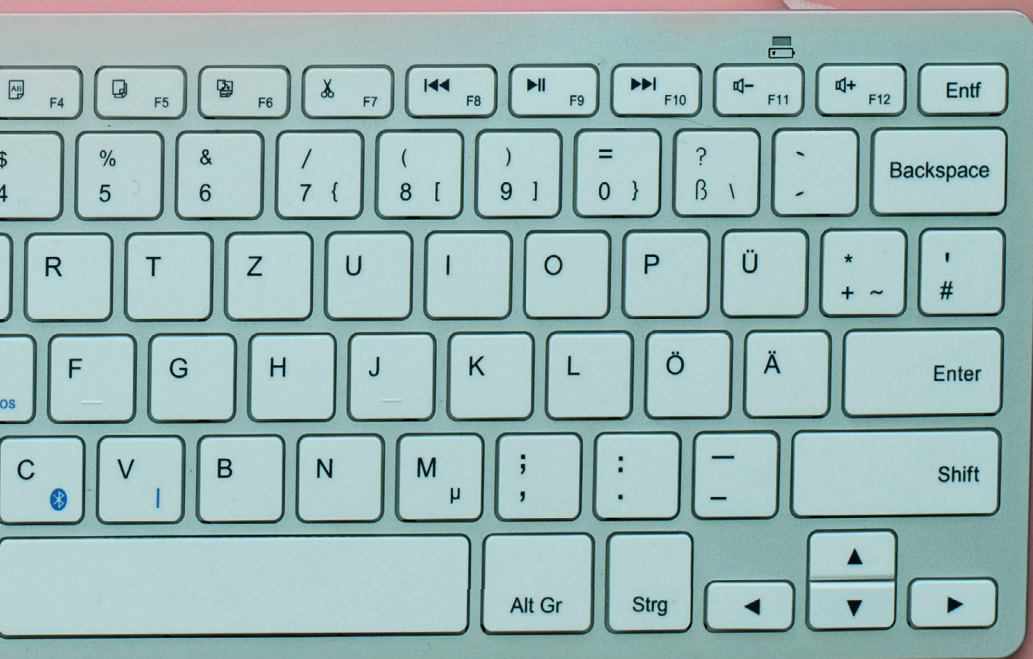




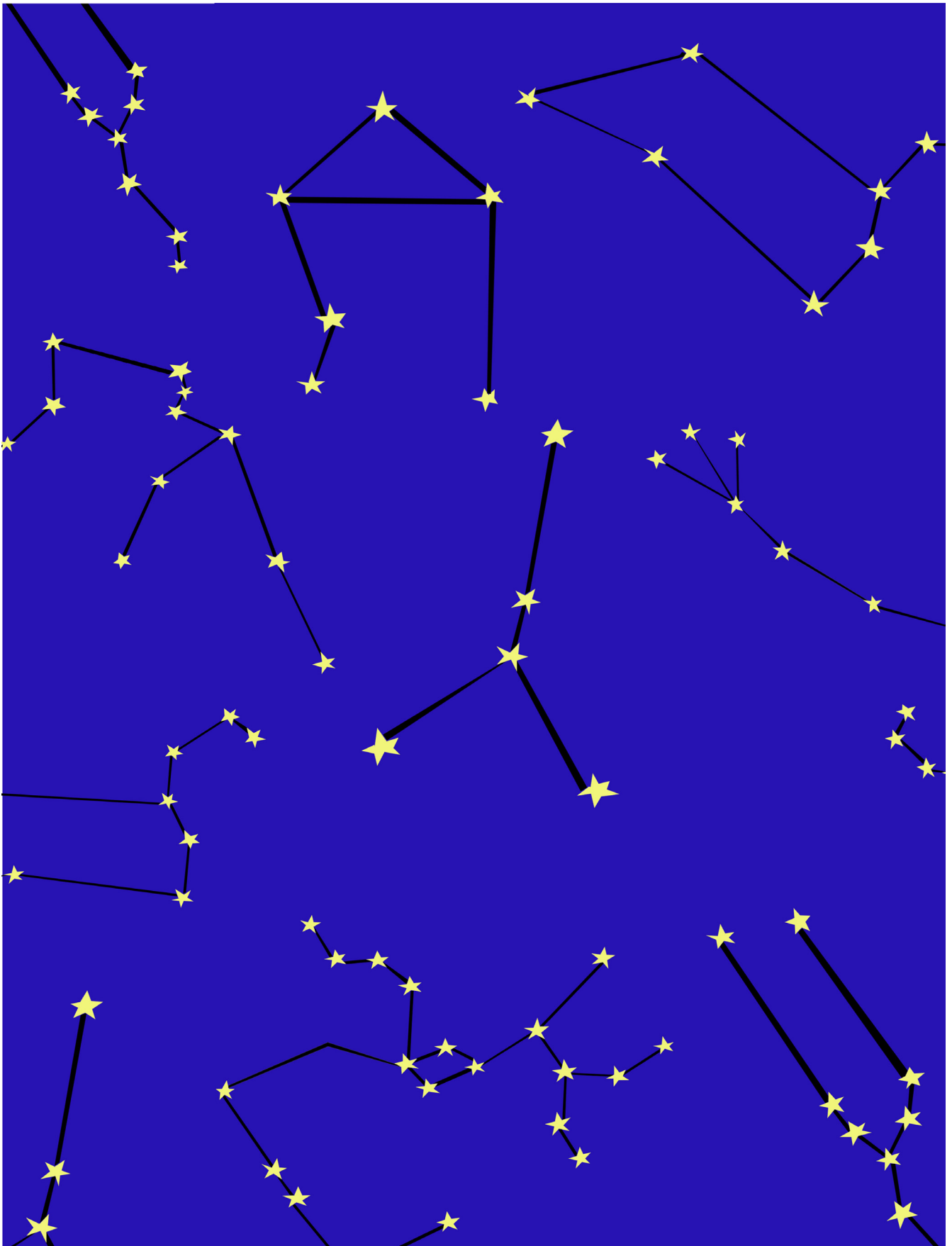
The Tale of Scorpio Secondary Pattern





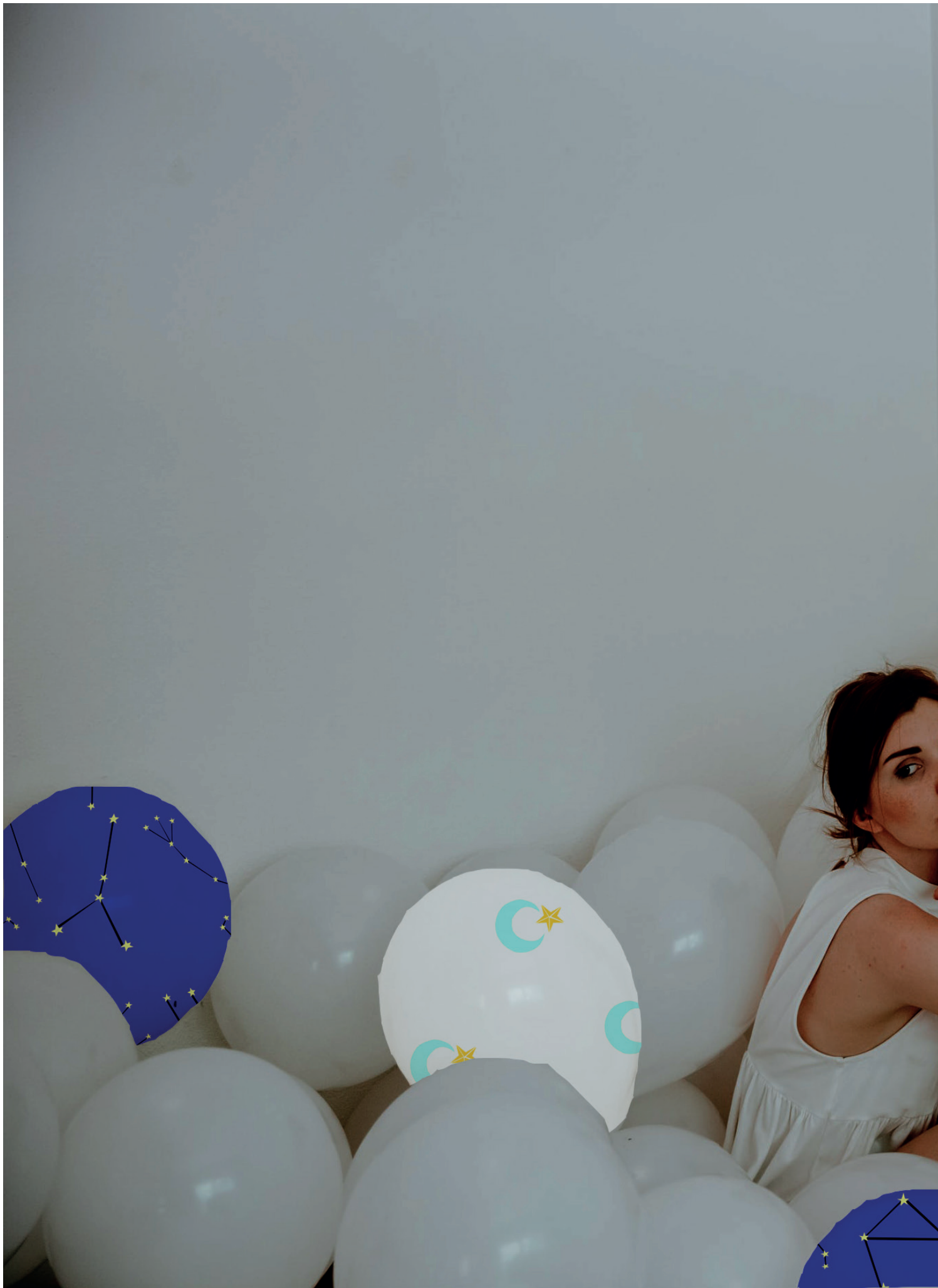


Constellations up Above Secondary Pattern



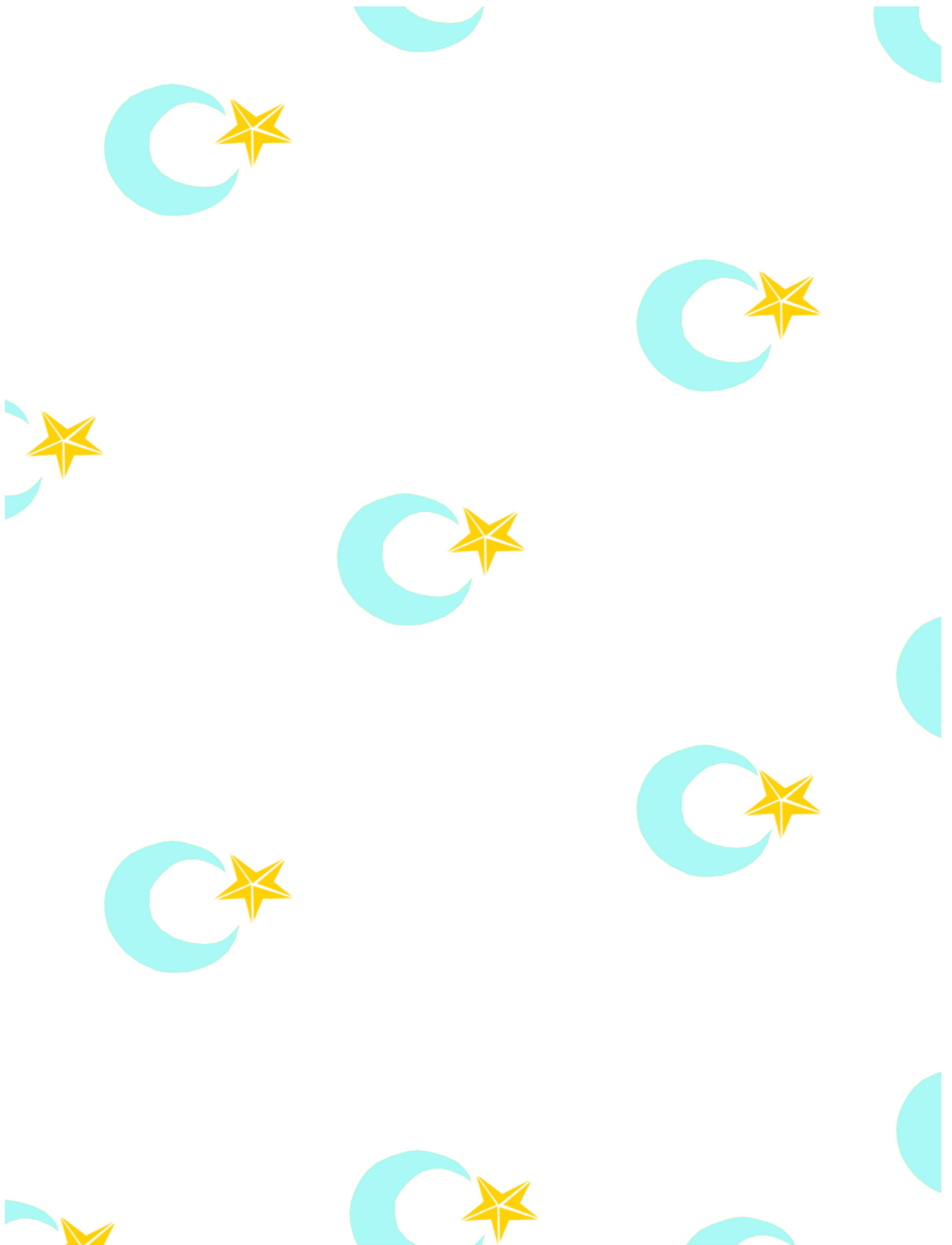
Scorpionian Texture Blender Pattern

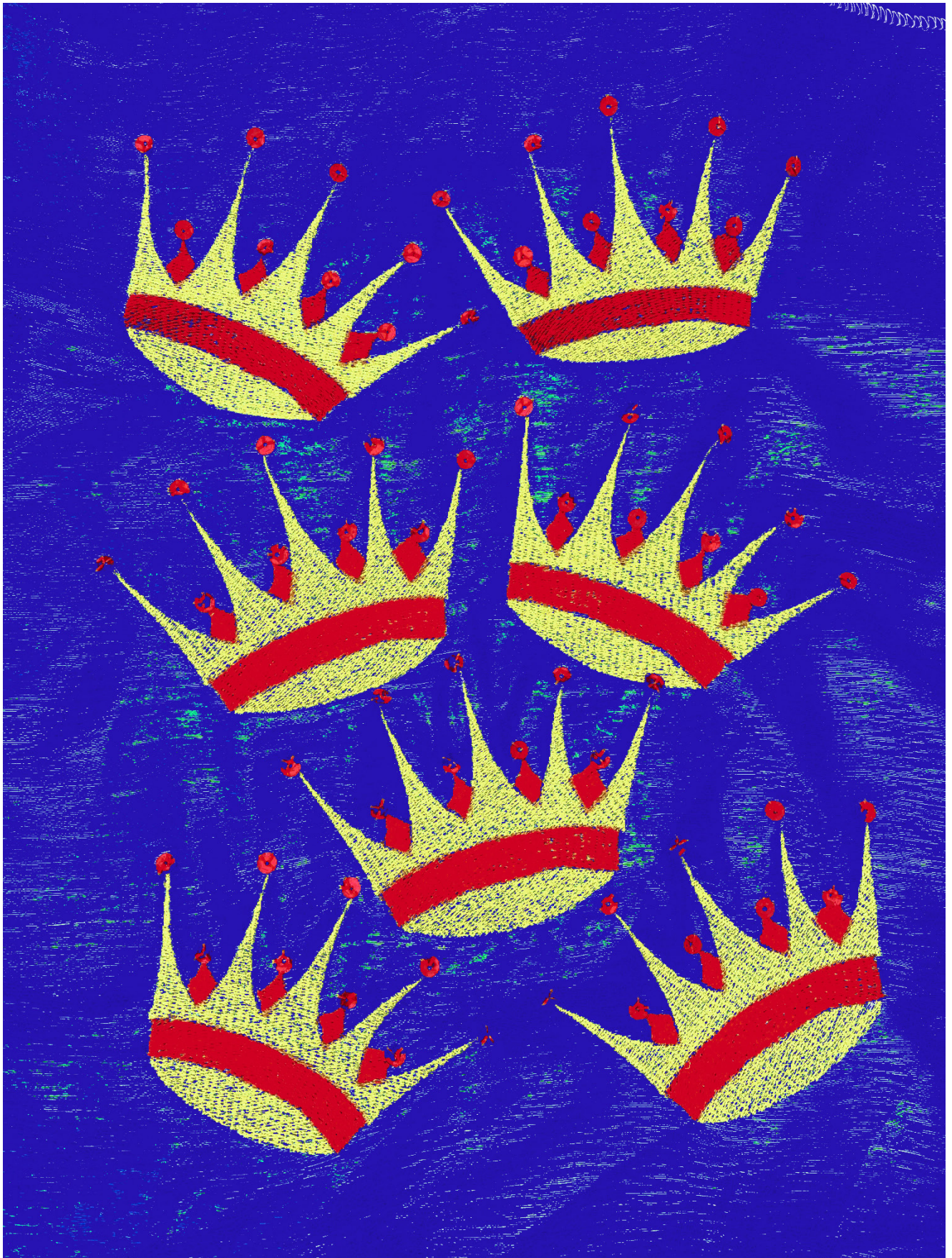

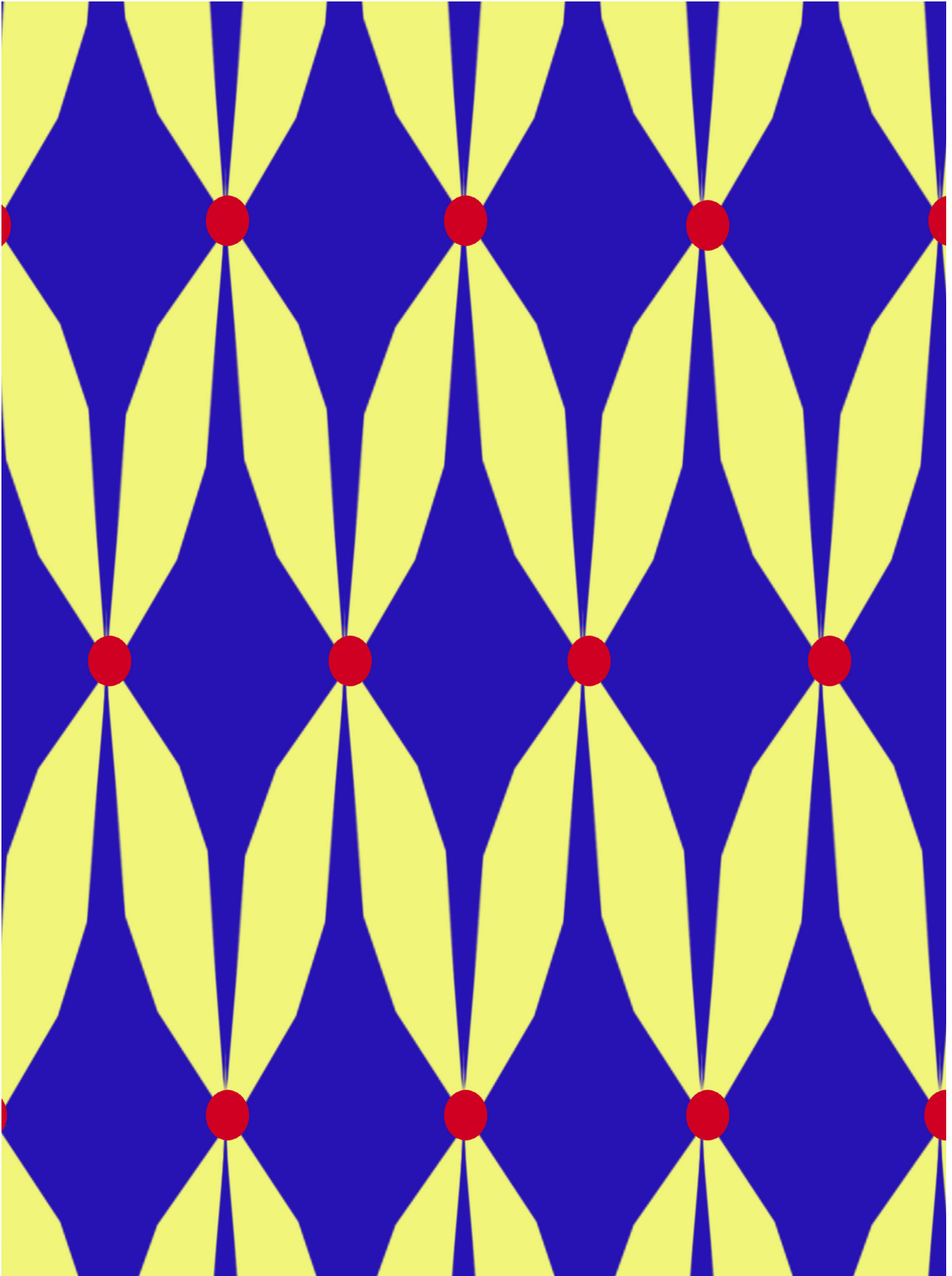

Purple gem

This pattern is a repeat tile which i have chosen to put on to a silk fabric. I feel this is a bold pattern with bright vibrant colours.

Emerald

I choose to use the Emerald gem as it is the chosen gem of the horoscope taurus. As it is a geometric shape i chose to put it in a half drop repeat pattern.

The blue of a Sapphire

This sapphire pattern was made knowing that it was going to be hand embellished. This is why there are some gaps in the flat pattern. You can see the embelishments on the pencil design. I chose to hand sew small diamonds in yellow as it is opposite on the colour wheel to make the design pop.

Amethyst

I choose to keep this design very geometric and tossed the different gems in varied sizes to create the croquis pattern.

A Handful of gems


